Federal law also required us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons City First Mortgage Corp chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Reasons we can share your personal information		Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes -- such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), responds to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus		
For our marketing purposes -- to offer our products and services to you		
For joint marketing with other financial companies		
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes -- information about your transactions and experiences		
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes -- information about your creditworthiness		
For our affiliates to market to you		
For nonaffiliates to market to you

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for non-affiliates to market to you

State Laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions**Affiliates**

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
